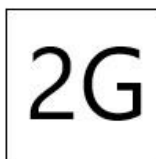

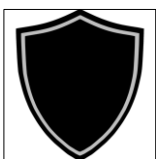

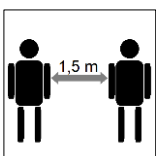
2G Corona rule

The 2G Corona rule applies. Each participant must be proven to be either recovered (max. 6 months after illness) or fully vaccinated (14 days after 2nd vaccination). Pupils (from 16 years of age only with school certificate) are subject to the 3G rule and are considered to have tested negative even without proof of testing.



Do you feel healthy?

As a participant of the tournament, you are obliged to take care of your health. If you have any symptoms of illness, do not show up at the venue and call the tournament management.



Minimum distance 1.5 meters

A minimum distance of 1.5 m should be maintained between participants. Avoid accumulations in door areas and at the tables. The minimum distance cannot be maintained at the board.



Mouth and nose covering

The wearing of a mouth and nose covering in the tournament hall is not required at the present time.



Wash and disinfect hands

Hands should be cleaned and disinfected regularly to avoid being a transmission surface for viruses.



Do not shake hands

Shaking hands is not allowed. At the beginning of the game, you can nod to each other as a substitute. To end a game of chess, simply stop the clock.



No watching

In order to be able to keep the prescribed minimum distance, walking around and watching at other boards is not allowed. Visitors are not allowed for the tournament.



Fresh air

A ventilation system ensures a constant supply of fresh air.

IMPORTANT: This hygiene concept is based on the "Regulation for Protection against New Infections with the Coronavirus SARS-CoV-2". Should the pandemic situation change, it may be necessary to adapt the rules.
